1. Satisfy the appropriate 50-hr Pre-Service Requirement

\$295 50-hr Pre-Service (Asynchronous) offered monthly
 VOPC Bridge Transfer (if you obtained a 50-hr VOPC from another institution) offered on demand

2a. After 50 hr Pre-Service Course AND obtaining a FT Lead Teacher role, Plan to begin the sequence of Phase 1, 2, 3 and Year 2 in the next available cohort.

2b. ALSO, after 50 hr Pre-Service Course, plan when you will take the Non-Sequence Courses as best fits your goals and schedule, you do not need to be teaching for these.
